

Students will be awarded the "Perfect Attendance Award" for the 2017-18 school year if they were present every school day, every period. According to the "State Student Attendance Handbook", the following absences are exempt when calculating the perfect attendance:

- Students who are on campus but not in their assigned classroom (Nurse, counselor, principal, etc.)
- Documented appointment for the student: Health Care Professional: Licensed, certified, or registered by an appropriate agency of the state of Texas
"The student must begin classes or return to school on the same day of the appointment"
- School Activity: Approved by local school board and under the direction of a professional staff member
- Religious Holy Day
- Taps: Military Honors Funeral
- Required Court Appearance
- Serving as a Student Early Voting Clerk: Election Clerk
- Student's own US Naturalization Oath Ceremony
- Junior or Senior year of high school and misses school for the purpose of visiting an institution of higher education
- Student is 17 years of age or older and pursuing enlistment in a branch of the United States Armed Services of the National Guard
